





MPOX update in Africa, officials launch response plan





In a significant step to strengthen and accelerate the response to the ongoing the mpox outbreak, the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) launched a joint continental response plan for Africa to support countries' efforts to curb the spread of the virus, save and protect lives.

MPOX infection prevention and control REMINDER



Avoid direct contact with mpox patients



Wear personal protective equipment (gown, gloves, eye protection and fitted N95 mask)



Cover the skin lesions of confirmed mpox patients



Use gloves while handling mpox patients' laundry



If available, place the mpox patient in a negative pressure room in the hospital

Mpox patients should self-isolate



Avoid intimate contact with someone infected or exposed to the mpox virus



Maintain good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette



Practice safe sex



Disinfect high-touch areas after having visitors at home



Saline drops reduce duration of common cold in kids



- ✓ Non-prescription saline nasal sprays and drops are used to keep nasal tissues moist, relieve nasal irritation, and help thick or dried mucus to drain.
- ✓ Saline nose sprays and drops can be purchased without a prescription or can be made easily at home.
- Using hypertonic saline nasal drops can reduce the length of the common cold in children by two days, according to a study that will be presented at the European Respiratory Society (ERS) Congress in Vienna, Austria.
- They can also reduce the onward transmission of colds to family members.
- The results of the ELVIS-Kids randomised controlled trial were presented by Professor Steve Cunningham from Child Life and Health, University of Edinburgh.



CDC Confirms Human H5 Bird Flu Case in Missouri

- ▶ This is the 14th human case of H5 reported in the USA during 2024
- first case of H5 without a known occupational exposure to sick or infected animals
- ▶ H5 outbreaks in cattle have not been reported in Missouri, but in commercial and backyard poultry flocks in 2024. H5N1 bird flu has been detected in wild birds in that state in the past.
- ► The specimen from the patient originally tested positive for influenza A, but negative for seasonal influenza A virus subtypes. That finding triggers additional testing.
- ► There has been no sign of unusual influenza activity in people, including in Missouri.
- Identification of the neuraminidase (the "N") in the patient specimen is pending further sequencing. Attempts to sequence the genome of the virus also are underway at CDC.
